U.S. 95 Thorncreek Road to Moscow breakfast meeting Tuesday (Aug. 9); information kiosk will be at Moscow Farmer's Market Saturday (Aug. 6)

LEWISTON — A breakfast meeting to provide an update about the U.S. 95 Thorncreek Road to Moscow project will be held Tuesday (Aug. 9), the Idaho Transportation Department announced.

The meeting will be at the Sandpiper Grill Restaurant (formerly known as the Mark IV), 414 N. Main St. in Moscow from 7 to 8 a.m. Meetings are held on the second Tuesday of each month at this time and location.

At Tuesday's breakfast meeting, project staff will discuss the latest developments on the project and answer questions.

The breakfast meeting topic will be the study methods used during the hazardous materials survey of the project area. The predominant hazardous materials observed were aboveground storage tanks (ASTs) for petroleum products, and propane tanks.

Denise Stark, an Environmental Planner with North Wind, Inc., led the hazardous materials survey.

Coffee will be provided at the meeting. Attendees are encouraged to order breakfast at their own expense.

The information kiosk, currently located at the Palouse Mall, will be at the Moscow Farmer's Market on Saturday (Aug. 6). The Farmer's Market is downtown in the Friendship Square parking lot from 8 a.m. to noon. ITD staff will be available to answer questions.
