**U.S. 95 Thorncreek Road to Moscow breakfast meeting Tuesday (Feb. 14);

LEWISTON – A breakfast meeting to provide an update about the U.S. 95 Thorncreek Road to Moscow project will be held Tuesday (Feb. 14), the Idaho Transportation Department (ITD) announced.
