

U.S. 95 THORNCREEK ROAD TO MOSCOW

CONSTRUCTION UPDATE

Here's what to expect in the next few months for the two U.S. 95 projects between the Top of Lewiston Hill and Thorncreek Road.

TOP OF LEWISTON HILL TO GENESEE

The contractor will start work this spring on the new southbound lane from north of Leon Road to the Top of Lewiston Hill. Once this section is complete, work on the new northbound lane will continue. Paving is anticipated to start in the fall, and both lanes are expected to be completed in late 2007. Meanwhile, work will resume on the two structures at Cow Creek and Calf Creek.

GENESEE TO THORNCREEK ROAD

When weather permits, the contractor will grind several locations in the road where bumps have occurred. Final striping for the roadway will be completed later this spring/summer.

Motorists can expect minor delays in both project areas while traffic is diverted from one lane to the other. Traffic is being stopped only to allow trucks to enter the highway when visibility is limited.
