

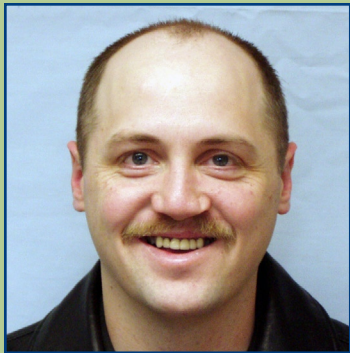

U.S. 95 THORNCREEK ROAD TO MOSCOW PROFILE: CURTIS ARNZEN

In March, the Idaho Transportation Department (ITD) welcomed Curtis Arnzen as the new Project Development Engineer for ITD's District 2. Curtis replaced Dave Kuisti, who moved to District 3 last year.

Curtis oversees all design projects in District 2. He supervises 14 employees in the Design, Location Surveying, Local Roads and Right-of-Way sections of ITD. Projects range in complexity from a simple seal coat to a full reconstruction project like the Thorncreek Road to Moscow project. His role with this project will be reviewing all of the design plans and overseeing the right-of-way phase once the Environmental Impact Statement is finished and approved.

Curtis most recently worked as the assistant city engineer in Lewiston. He was raised on a farm near Cottonwood, Idaho and received an engineering degree at the University of Idaho.
